



## RedRover Readers Volunteer Code of Conduct

As a volunteer with RedRover representing the RedRover Readers program, I agree that my voluntary participation is contingent upon adhering to the Code of Conduct below.

I agree that as a volunteer with the RedRover Readers program, I shall:

1. Be free of any arrests or convictions for crimes against children or animals, and agree to background checks and/or fingerprinting as needed;
2. Always require that I am not left alone with any group of children for any length of time, that I am always accompanied by a teacher, teacher's aide or other school or site representative;
3. Follow all RedRover policies and procedures related to the program;
4. Avoid presenting ideologies not in alignment with the RedRover Readers program and RedRover's mission;
5. Follow all the rules and regulations for guests of the school, after-school program, library, youth group or other facility where the RedRover's event is occurring;
6. Never be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while volunteering;
7. Only use the approved fliers and brochures, books and discussion guides, unless otherwise approved by a RedRover staff member;
8. Not bring an animal to a RedRover Readers program unless approved by a RedRover staff member;
9. Report all RedRover Readers-related events and activities in a timely fashion to a RedRover staff member as directed; and
10. I understand that the RedRover Readers program strives to provide opportunities for children to discuss the human-animal bond and will try to help in this effort.

RedRover reserves the right to suspend or deactivate any volunteer for breach of this code of conduct.
